## COMING 2024: TRADITION & DISCOVERY 4.0

2024 marks the 50<sup>th</sup> volume of *Tradition & Discovery* and so is a fitting time for changes to the journal. Starting in January, articles will be posted as pdf files *seriatim* (as soon they are ready) on the Polanyi Society website.

At the end of the year, all articles will be compiled into a "bound electronic volume" so as to allow those who would like to do so to download and print the complete volume.

Articles will continue to be indexed.

Making this change means that we are no longer bound by the deadlines required for publishing three issues/year. We hope that this will result in publishing articles sooner.

Yes, this marks yet another change in the history of *Tradition & Discovery*, but if you explore the archives on the Polanyi Society website, it is apparent that the publication has always been evolving.

What I now call version 1.0 was more a newsletter than a journal. Version 2.0 was a mix of newsletter and journal published two times per year in house. Version 2.1 continued that mix of content but was published three times per year in house.

When we outsourced production to Faithlab, we became version 3.0, a print journal published three times per year. Version 3.1, continued the relationship with Faithlab but because of COVID disruptions with printers quit printing hardcopies and became a journal posted three times per year on the Society website.

As we continue with Faithlab for version 4.0, the editorial board and I expect not only to continue, but also to enhance the quality of our offerings.
